Information for Consigners

- Lots must be philatelic in nature.
- Consignors do not have to be a member of the BC Philatelic Society.
- Lots must be in a cigar box or bigger, or a 16-page stockbook or bigger. No single stamps or sets will be accepted.
- Lots will have a starting bid of \$25.00 and will have an expected selling price averaging at least \$40 per lot. There will be no reserves other than the opening minimum.
- There is a limit of 10 lots per consignor, subject to the availability, within the auction limit of 150 lots. Donation lots will be accepted and are not counted as one of a consignor's auction lots.
- This signed, consignment form should be submitted to the auctioneer as soon as possible, and the physical lots must be in the auctioneer's hands by August 5, 2023. The auctioneer will have full, non-appealable, discretion over which lots are accepted, and reserves the right to change the consignor's description or estimate and to split or combine lots.
- The BC Philatelic Society will take 10% of the selling price as a commission.
- Consignors are responsible for their own insurance, and the BC Philatelic Society, the Jubilee United Church and/or the Security company, including its officers, employees and volunteers cannot be held responsible for any theft, loss or damage to auction lots while in possession of the auctioneer or the BCPS.
- Payout to consignors will happen no later than October 31, 2023.

Information for bidders

- Lots are sold as-is, where-is. Returns are not accepted.
- The auctioneer will have sole authority over bidding increments and disputes.
- There is no buyer's premium, lot fee, nor any provincial or federal sales taxes charged.
- Lots must be paid for and removed by the purchaser by the end of the show, Saturday, September 30th at 4pm.
- There will be no shipping of items. Anyone not present at the auction will have to make arrangements to pay and pick up successful purchases before the close of the show at 4pm on Saturday September 30th.
